COMMUNITY

Marlington High School is a public high school located in Lexington Township, near the city of Alliance, in Stark County, Ohio. The school district is comprised of three elementary schools, one middle school, and one high school. Marlington High School is a four-year public high school with an enrollment of 663 students.

CURRICULUM

The academic program is organized by a 10 period daily schedule with academic assist periods consisting of 43 or 52 minutes. The school year is divided quarterly with credits awarded per semester. Marlington High School's academic offerings include a traditional curriculum, Honors level courses, College Credit Plus, and Career and Technical programs.

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP)

Students can earn both high school and college credit for CCP courses. CCP courses can be taken at the college or at the high school. Marlington CCP courses are taught by our teachers who are adjunct professors per the respective university/college standards. Courses are available through Stark State College and Kent State University. The following CCP courses are taught at Marlington:

College Composition I, College Composition II, Intro to Communication, College Algebra, Trigonometry, Statistics, Calculus, Chemistry I, Chemistry II, General Biology I, General Biology II, College Success Skills, Intermediate Spanish I, Intermediate Spanish II, Computer Applications, US History I, US History II

CAREER TECHNICAL PROGRAMS

Marlington offers several career technical programs that students can take their junior and senior year. Career Technical programs prepare students to enter the workforce or enter a two-year or four-year degree upon completion of the program. Marlington also partners with Alliance High School to allow students to attend career tech programs at either building. Marlington offers the following career technical programs:
